

Privacy Policy for Alief Hastings Class of 1977 50th Reunion Website

Effective Date: June 24, 2026

Alief Hastings Class of 1977 50th Reunion Committee (“we,” “us,” or “our”) operates the website [insert website URL, e.g., aliefhastings77reunion.com] (the “Site”) to facilitate planning, registration, communication, and sharing related to the 50th reunion of the Alief Hastings High School Class of 1977. **We are committed to protecting your privacy** and handling any personal information responsibly. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit or use the Site.

By accessing or using the Site, you agree to the practices described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree, please do not use the Site.

Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

- **Personal Information You Provide Voluntarily:** When you register for the reunion, RSVP, purchase tickets, submit photos or memories, contact us, or participate in forms, surveys, or forums, we may collect:
 - Contact details (name, email address, phone number, mailing address).
 - Class-related information (graduation year, student ID if provided, biographical details, or memories).
 - Payment information (processed via third-party payment processors; we do not store full credit card details).
 - Photos, videos, or other media you upload.
 - Any other information you choose to provide.
- **Automatically Collected Information:** As you browse the Site, we or our service providers may collect:
 - Usage data (IP address, browser type, device information, pages visited, time spent).
 - Cookies and similar tracking technologies (see “Cookies and Tracking” section below).
- **Information from Third Parties:** We may receive limited information from alumni databases, school records (with appropriate permissions), or public sources to help locate classmates, but only as necessary for reunion purposes.

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 18. If we become aware that we have collected such data, we will take steps to delete it.

How We Use Your Information

We use the collected information for the following purposes:

- Organizing and promoting the reunion (e.g., sending updates, RSVPs, event details).

- Processing registrations, payments, and attendance.
- Facilitating classmate connections and sharing memories/photos (with your consent where applicable).
- Improving the Site and user experience.
- Responding to your inquiries and providing customer support.
- Complying with legal obligations or protecting our rights.

We do not sell your personal information for monetary compensation.

Sharing and Disclosure of Information

We may share your information in VERY limited circumstances:

- **With Reunion Organizers and Volunteers:** Class committee members or volunteers who need access to coordinate the event.
- **Service Providers:** Third-party vendors who assist with website hosting, email communications, payment processing, event management, or analytics (e.g., under contracts that require them to protect your data).
- **Publicly on the Site:** Photos, memories, or directory information you voluntarily submit and consent to share with other attendees (you can request removal of your content where possible).
- **Legal Reasons:** If required by law, subpoena, or to protect the safety, property, or rights of the committee, users, or the public.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, acquisition, or similar transaction (though HIGHLY unlikely for this volunteer-run effort).

We do not share personal contact information broadly with all alumni unless you specifically consent or it is limited to official reunion planning.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies

The Site may use cookies, web beacons, or similar technologies to enhance functionality, analyze traffic, and personalize content. You can manage cookie preferences through your browser settings. We do not use tracking for targeted advertising purposes unrelated to the reunion. Your information and data WILL NOT BE SOLD OR GIVEN TO ANYONE.

Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect your personal information. However, no method of transmission or storage is 100% secure. We cannot guarantee absolute security.

Your Rights and Choices (Including CCPA for California Residents)

General Rights: You may request to access, correct, or delete your personal information by contacting us. We will respond within a reasonable timeframe, subject to verification and legal requirements.

For California Residents (CCPA/CPRA): If you are a California resident, you have additional rights regarding your personal information, including the right to know what personal information we have collected about you, the right to delete it, and the right to opt out of the sale of personal information (we do not sell it). You may exercise these rights free of charge (up to twice per 12-month period for certain requests) by contacting us. We will not discriminate against you for exercising your rights.

Data Retention

We retain your information only as long as necessary for the purposes outlined in this policy, or as required by law. After the reunion, we may archive certain data for historical purposes or delete it upon request.

Third-Party Links

The Site may contain links to external websites. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of those sites. We encourage you to review their privacy policies.

Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy periodically. We will post the revised version with a new effective date. Continued use of the Site after changes constitutes acceptance of the updated policy.
